Study 3– Genesis 2:1-2:25

1. How did the first man, Adam, come into existence? Do you think this is a literal account of how the first person was made on our planet? Why or why not? If it is literal, how do you think God actually did it?
2. In your opinion, what word bests or most accurately describes God's infinite power and unlimited capabilities? Why does this word best describe God's immeasurable ability to do and create whatever He wants?
3. According to the Bible, how did the first woman come into existence? Do you think that this is a literal description of how the woman was made? Why or why not? If it is literal, why do you think that God created her in this manner?
4. **Genesis 1:27** tells us that both Adam and Eve were "*made in the image of God.*" Do you think that you are made in the 'image of God'? Why or why not? If you are made 'in God's image,' describe how and why you are made in God's image and what your purpose is as a result. What do you think are the 1-4 main reasons why God created you and had you birthed in this world?
5. Why do you think that God made a woman for Adam? In other words, what were (or are) the purposes for Adam and Eve together, especially at this point in history? How does Adam respond when he sees the woman God made for him? How do they respond together as a result? What, if anything, is the message to you in God's creation of Adam and Eve?
6. What does it the Bible mean when it states that Adam and his wife, Eve "*became one flesh*"? Why do you think they were not ashamed or embarrassed about their nakedness at this time? What, if anything, is the message to you personally in this account of Adam and Eve?
