

God Plagues Egypt

Study 20: Exodus 6 - 11

1. What most stands out to you in this reading? What questions, if any, do you have after reading these chapters?
2. According to the LORD, what is His primary reason for saving Israel and initiating these plagues upon Egypt (6:2-7, 7:4-5, 17, 8:22, 9:14-16, 10:1-2)? Why do you think God wanted this to be known?
3. In chapter 7, Moses and Aaron visit Pharaoh for the first time. What happens when Aaron throws his staff on the floor before Pharaoh? How does this happen? What does Pharaoh do to challenge Aaron and his staff miracle? How did Pharaoh's servants to this? What happens to the staffs in the end? What if anything is the message to you in this entire situation?
4. How does Pharaoh respond when asked if *"he will let the people of Israel go out of the land of Egypt"* (7:1-4)? According to the passage, why does Pharaoh's heart respond this way? What, if anything, is the message to you in this situation? Suggested Reading: *Exodus 4:21*
5. List in order the **10 plagues** (10th plague promised in chapter 11) that God strikes against Egypt? In your opinion, which one seems the worst? Why did God execute all of these plagues against Egypt? How do you think God actually caused these plagues to occur?
6. What impact did these plagues have upon the Israelite community? In other words, did any of the plagues hit or burden Israel? Why or why not? What if anything does this say to you about God, His power, His favor, His sovereignty, and or His ways?
